All young people have a right to protection with individual needs or vulnerability taken into account. Adhering to good practice guidelines and Omega procedures will help ensure the safeguarding and protection of young people involved in our activities.

This policy aims to keep young people safe by:

- Providing them with appropriate safety and protection whilst in our care.
- Training staff to make informed and confident responses to specific child protection issues.
- Exceeding minimum requirements for safeguarding young people.
